Thank you for registering your capabilities on the Unmanned Air Systems Capability Development Centre (UAS CDC) Open Supplier Register (OSR).

The UAS CDC has received an initial requirement from the Royal School of Artillery (RSA) who are looking at the process to become a certified Unmanned Air System (UAS) flying instruction organisation.

We are therefore looking for a suitable individual(s) who can provide consultancy support to the UAS CDC to assist in putting together an initial roadmap of what tasks are required to be undertaken for RSA compliance with RA2125(1).

It is envisaged that a number of meetings/workshops will be held with stakeholders to scope out the scale of the task and identify those areas where the UAS CDC and the consultant may be able to provide subsequent support. At this stage we are looking to identify a suitable candidate(s) who can support the UAS CDC on an ad-hoc day rate basis.

Responsibilities

- Provide Subject Matter Expertise to the UAS CDC on issues associated with setting up a Flying Instruction Organisation covering training, regulatory and assurance areas.
- Attend stakeholder meetings and workshops as required.
- Produce material to support meetings and workshops as requested.

Attributes:

- Understanding of RPAS assurance and governance, including MAA MRPs and duty holders' flying orders, Air Safety Management Plans and associated policies;
- Awareness of current military aircrew training;
- Understanding of Army RPAS capabilities from an operating, training and safety perspective;
- Experience in interacting with military stakeholders;
- SC Clearance.

If you believe you have the appropriate skill set and would wish to support the UAS CDC. You will be required to provide adequate information to demonstrate this by way of a summary or a full CV, along with an associated day-rate. This will allow the UAS CDC and stakeholders to assess your suitability to provide consultancy support.
